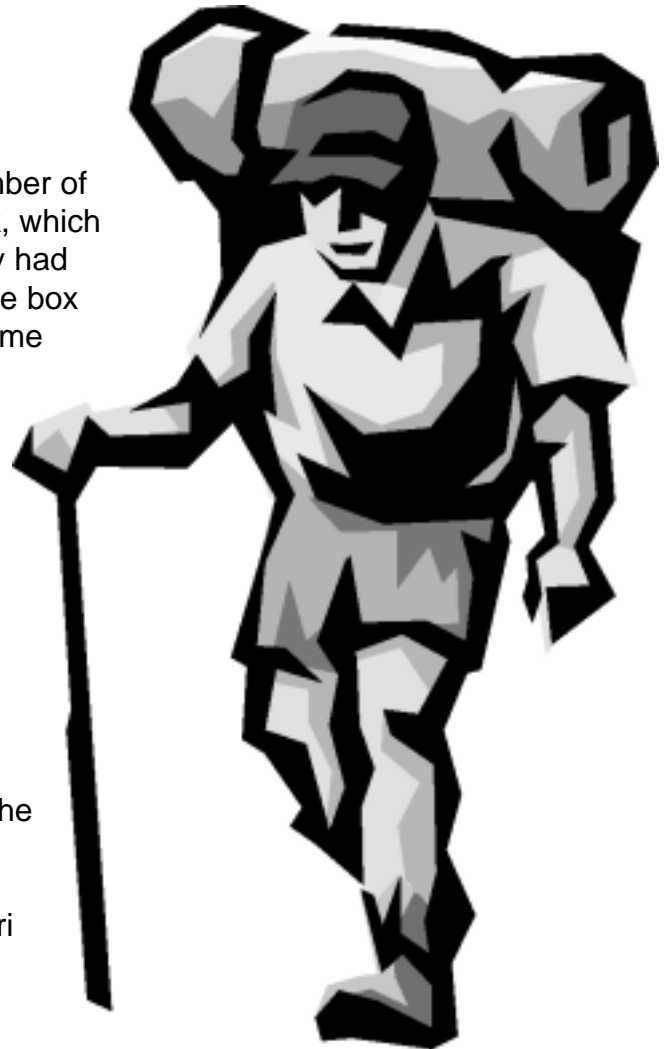

Battelle Darby Creek is the largest Metro Park in the Columbus area with more than 6,500 acres of prairies, fields and forests. Stretches along more than 14 miles of the Big and Little Darby creeks, designated as state and national scenic rivers. 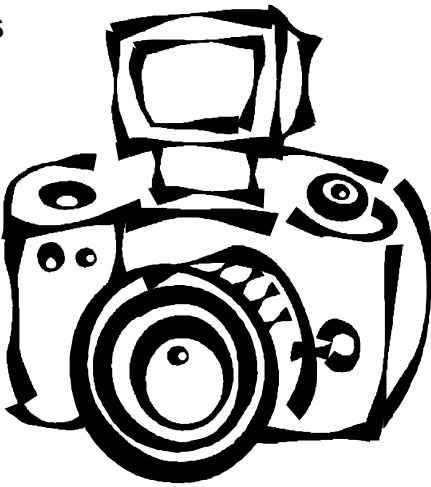
### Gear Fest 2007, Saturday, Oct. 7
